

REGULATION OF INTERNATIONAL AWARD FOR ARTS AND LETTERS BLESSED "Don Giustino Russolillo"

Art. 1 – Eight (8) sections are expected:

- Sect. A Religious poetry (on Blessed Giustino Russolillo);
- Sect. B Poetry in Italian Language (on any subject);
- Sect. C Poetry in Neapolitan Dialect and in all Italian dialects – On any subject (maximum of 30 lines with translation – with the exclusion of those in Neapolitan);
- Sect. D Published book of poetry in any language as long as translated into Italian;
- Sect. E Religious poetry in all Italian and Foreign Languages (on any subject);
- Sect. F Narrative (short stories);
- Sect. G Youth Section;
- Sect. H Artistic: Participants are required to send two (2) color or black and white of two different works, format 20x25, of Painting, Drawing, Watercolor, Graphics, Sculpture, Photography, Collectibles, Crafts or, of products created with any creative technique. Photos must be noted on the back with name, surname, address, telephone number, email address and technique used.

Art. 2 - Works must be sent registered mail to: Associazione “Amici di Don Giustino Onlus” Via Parroco G. Russolillo, 14 c/o Vocazionario Deus Caritas – 80126 Napoli not later than December 10th. Outer envelope should read “Premio Beato G. Russolillo” and the related section(s) must be indicated. For additional information, please contact: Cav. Participants are required to send six (6) copies (of which only one must be signed and must state name, surname, address, telephone number and email address) of the works relating to sections A, B, C, E, F, G.

Two (2) copies of the works relating to section D must be sent together with the participant’s contact information.

Art. 3 – Although this is a non-profit prize, sections B, C, D, E, F, H require a contribution of € 10 for partial covering of secretarial expenses for each section to be included in the envelope containing the works. Participation to sections A and G is free of charge.

Art. 4 - For Sections A, B, C, E: participants may submit a maximum of three (3) poems whose length is not to exceed 30 lines.

Art. 5 - For Section D: participants may submit one poetry book. Two copies must be provided.

Art. 6 - For Section F: participants may submit a short story on any subject of a maximum of five (5) pages, 30 lines per page including spaces.

Art. 7 - For Section G: participants must not be older than 19 years on the date of the competition. They may submit a poem (maximum 30 lines) or a short story on any subject and/or on Blessed Giustino Russolillo (five (5) pages maximum, 30 lines per page including spaces) in any language and must be translated in Italian. Six (6) copies must be sent, of which only one must be signed and must state name, surname, address, telephone number and email address and a copy of picture ID.

Art. 8 - Foreign works must be translated into Italian or will be excluded from the competition.

Art. 9 - The awards ceremony will take place in Naples during the months of April – May 2013. All participants will receive a written evaluation by the jury (whose verdict is unquestionable) together with the names of the winners and the place of delivery of the prizes. The names of the jury will be announced on the day of the award.

Art. 10 -The organization reserves the right to publish and distribute, at its discretion, the participants’ works in an anthology with the list of the authors. The authors of the works, which may be published and distributed, waive any remuneration for such work while retaining the artistic and literary property.

Art. 11 - The following prizes are foreseen:

- Sect. A – 1st Place – € 50 and a painting by Cav. Vincenzo Russo; 2nd and 3rd Place – personalized trophy;
- Sect. B – 1st Place - € 50 and a painting by Cav. Vincenzo Russo; 2nd and 3rd Place – personalized trophy;
- Sect. C, D, E, F, G, H – 1st Place - € 50 and a personalized trophy; 2nd and 3rd Place – personalized trophy.

Other prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the jury to those works worthy of mention.

Art. 12 - Personal data will be treated solely for the purposes related to the competition.

Art. 13- Prizes not collected will be shipped with tax payable by the recipient.
